

The Harold V. Felton and Ferne R. Felton Scholarship

The selection committee of The Harold V. Felton and Ferne R. Felton Scholarship will accept applications from candidates for two scholarships to be awarded to selected graduates of Vinton County High School for each year. An applicant must be a member of the current graduating class of Vinton County High School. The applicant must have attended Vinton County High School for two or more years and enroll in a college or university located in the State of Ohio. One scholarship will be awarded to a student planning to major in Elementary Education and one to a student planning to major in Secondary Education. The award will be a fixed dollar amount, based on interest earned on the endowment provided by Mr. & Mrs. Felton, held by the Vinton County School Education Foundation, Inc. Deadline for receipt of applications is April 15 of each year.

If you are interested, please send a letter to The Harold V. Felton and Ferne R. Felton Scholarship, c/o Cotner, Cooley & Clark, LLC, P.O. Box 313, McArthur, OH 45651-0313. **Indicate in your letter whether you intend to become an elementary or secondary school teacher.** Include your mailing address, your email address (if you actively monitor it) and telephone number in your letter. If you provide a telephone number, indicate whether you can accept text messages on that number. Include the name of the college that you plan to attend.

Also, enclose a copy of the page from applicant's *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* form that indicates the student's EFC number. EFC is the abbreviation for "expected family contribution". The form must include the identity of the student. Financial aid will be the key factor to be considered by the trustees when selecting between otherwise qualified candidates.
